# 1 - Start of a struggle for the dignity of man

In 1975, at the beginning of the Lebanese civil war, Yvonne Chami returns to Beirut after six years in Vietnam in difficult conditions, as a nurse.

She finds a job in the pediatric ward of a hospital in the capital and discovers a disturbing reality: children becoming disabled while we could prevent the onset of disability, families disintegrating and the country's resources not allowing making any response to this dramatic situation, especially as the ongoing conflict is not giving the case of these children a priority.

Yvonne then drew this dream to accompany the lives of children with disability from birth to death, to enable them to lead a life of dignity and to become at their turn witnesses bearing a message to others.

## Our Logo

Two candles of different sizes, united by the same flame, this is our emblem to show the breath of life. We consider the right symbolizes a healthy person, and the other, leaning, children with disability. It especially covers joining a person's system of values, beliefs, crossing his vision and walking with him in his environment, in his society.

• Each child is unique! His treatment is tailored and so the importance of the individualized project.

• We build a real partnership with the family, because we believe that disability is not an enough reason to exclude the child with disability; it is also essential to support the family especially the mother, to avoid her exhaustion, to reduce the family burden from disability and its requirements.

## TRANSPARENCY

SESOBEL is independent of any religious or political authority to maintain its moral and financial freedom. Furthermore, 69% of SESOBEL's funds come from self-financing activities, private resources, allowing the association to maintain its autonomy.

For full transparency towards donors, accounting is annually subject to control by two auditors appointed by the General Meeting and SESOBEL's Board of Directors.

The accounts are audited by the Lebanese Cabinet «Anthony J. Haddad» and the French Cabinet «Ernst & Young».



## DEVELOP TO BETTER SERVE The Continuous Training Center

Several trainings were conducted under the SESOBEL Continuous Training Center during the year 2015 - 2016 in order to:

1) Raise environmental cause and the rights of the person with disability.

2) Promote quality of care and support for people with disability.

3) Strengthen the intervention capabilities and expertise of the professionals working with people with disability.

4) Involve parents in the implementation of the life project of their child fostering his integration into the socio-economic structure.

From July 2015 until June 2016, The SESOBEL Continuous Education Center organized:

28 training modules divided into 68 sessions for 361 participants.

The training modules were conducted by 16 professionals from SESOBEL, 4 foreign experts and 16 Lebanese experts (4 Lebanese persons and 3 groups from the American University of Beirut consisting of 12 medical students).

The modules were made up of 14 technical trainings and administrative trainings The participants :

262 professionals, including: 236 professionals working at SESOBEL, 10 professionals working in Lebanese socio-medical establishments, 16 professionals working with external services. 63 Parents.

An interesting display of different types of material on the seating position and assistive technology accompanied the multiple scientific conferences during the 3 days, animated by well-known international speakers.

# "International conference on cerebral palsy and other childhood on set disabilities" – Stockholm

4 people from SESOBEL participated in an international conference entitled "International conference on cerebral palsy and other childhood on set disabilities", at Stockholm-Sweden from 1 to 4 June 2016.

This conference brought together several international organizations from 66 countries and beyond 1500 professionals working with children with disability.

SESOBEL participated by presenting four posters and one verbal communication.

The congress allowed the units (Speech and physical therapy) to be up-to-date on all the

news, which can be incorporated and applied on our children and to subsequently improve the quality of services offered by SESOBEL medical team.

## **PROJECTS CARRIED OUT IN 2015 – 2016**

## Waterproofing, tents & playground

Thanks to the contribution of the LORD MICHELHAM OF HELLINGLY Foundation, MUREX SAL, the LIBANO-FRANCAISE Bank and Mrs. Raya Raphael Nahas, the SESOBEL was able to set up an indoor playground and two tents to avoid the rain and to ensure an adequate, protected, entertaining, educational and rehabilitative environment to our children and youth with disability.



## **Refrigerated room**

The SESOBEL was selected among other associations to benefit from the support of the «Recettes de Vie» Association to set up a refrigerated room needed for developing and operating the kitchen and cafeteria protected workshop where 10 of our youth with disability are working.

The affiliated association of Partage, Partage Région Nantaise, has covered the costs of training provided by professionals in the CTC and one professional training abroad.

**Continuous Training Center - CTC** 

These trainings were addressed:

To the mothers of our children in order to help them better manage conflict situations resulted from tensions and provide them with a professional training to find work, to have more autonomy and to help their families. 22 mothers benefited from these courses.

To professionals and supervisors to increase their knowledge and improve their work techniques for a better quality of service and better supervision.

• The pedagogical head unit in charge of children at the multiple disabilities program is following an overseas training over 3 years, entitled «Specialized pedagogy with the inclusion of Stimulation Basal approach". This Training will be lately transmitted to the whole team.

## Living space

NEXT CARE Dubai has provided some of the operating costs of SESOBEL's «Living space»: a temporary foster home for autistic youngsters, adapted to their disability in which they can discover and learn to live independently away from their home setting. This foster accommodates 13 of our autistic youth twice a week.

## The cafeteria of the «3 Hearts Lodge»

Thanks to a generous philanthropist, we were able to renovate the cafeteria that serves lunch for lunch prepared in the kitchen of SESOBEL to our children and youth.



## Local produce

The Lebanese Industry Value Chain Development (LIVCD) - funded by USAID - provided its support and professional assistance to help us develop our production workshop of local produce.



#### Objectives:

- Introduce new equipments needed to increase production capacity and reduce costs, while respecting the recommended hygiene standards.

- Provide training to workers and farmers to improve the quality of their products.

We reiterate our sincere gratitude to all the friends who have helped us cover the medical expenses and chronic medications of our youth, and the necessary equipment for the operation of workshops and classes.

A big thank you also to all those who responded to our call with medical emergency.

## Inauguration of the new Diagnostic Center of Support and Rehabilitation D.A.R

Given that SESOBEL is located faraway in Ain El Rihani, and thanks to a generous donor who put the local at our disposal, we opened in June 2016, the new Diagnostic Center of Support and Rehabilitation, D.A.R. at Dora, to make our services available to a larger number of beneficiaries.

This Center will take care of diagnostic and external services, specifically:

-Welcoming new families and determining their needs, first medical and paramedical studies (physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, psychomotor therapy, psychology) and educational assessments (remedial),

- First social studies,

- Comprehensive Rehabilitation Plan (personalized project)

- Information to the family about the disability of their child, his needs and existing alternatives on the ground,

- Child or youth orientation to the most appropriate structure, allowing him to benefit from a comprehensive care: educational, medical and rehabilitative.

- Orientation may be made to the programs of SESOBEL, to structures outside SESOBEL, or to an external care program that ensures: Examinations: Analysis of motion and movement, and the respiratory part (pulse oximeter, EFR...), balance assessments and rehabilitation, technical counseling, realization of technical aids...... etc.

In the case of External Care, educational monitoring and respiratory exams will be also offered at home.

## **The Anthem of SESOBEL**

To celebrate its 40th anniversary, SESOBEL organized the First Communion mass, which was celebrated by the Cardinal Mar Bechara Boutros Al Rai, the Maronite Patriarch, on May 14, 2016 at Bkerké for 16 children and youth with disability in the presence of their parents, friends and the SESOBEL team.

## EDITORIAL

## **40 YEARS OF LOVE**

## One of the most passionate adventures

François Mauriac once said: «We deserve our encounters.»

Meeting Yvonne, 40 years ago, was not coincidental. It was meant to be. Probably through the intercession of the Lord who wanted to cast His spell on me to serve her children ...

I was back then a young teenager, I loved helping and I chose a profession that allowed to do so, I didn't want to live my life without leaving a mark, I wanted for my life to have meaning ...

And it was exactly this encounter that allowed

me to live, for 40 years, the most passionate adventure, the adventure of SESOBEL. Because Yvonne, was the adventure.

Upon arriving to her place, during our first meetings, I have realized that the work she wanted me to do, require more than 24 hours per day to be achieved... I did not understand very well the importance of everything she asked me to do at first, but she was confident and seemed to know very well what she sought and how to get there....

Ever since, there were so many challenges to face and roads to travel, full of difficulties, obstacles, moments of weakness, uncertainty and despondency... but also beautiful moments of hope and joy...

40 years later, I am delighted to realize that the values Yvonne knew how to implant in our hearts and souls and that always

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
